Dear Chair DeFazio and Ranking Member Graves:

I am requesting funding for the Broadway Rehabilitation project in surface transportation reauthorization legislation.

The project sponsor is the City of Glendale, CA, and the project is located near the downtown district, on Broadway Avenue, between San Fernando Road and S. Central Avenue, and Kenilworth Avenue, between Broadway and W. Wilson Avenues, zip codes 91303 and 91204.

The funding is designated for the surface grinding and pavement of road, removal and repair of concrete improvements, such as sidewalks and driveways, removal and replacement of deteriorated traffic striping and pavement markings, which includes installation of advanced shared roadway green bicycle markings, and traffic signal modifications.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars and is anticipated to improve safety for all modes of transportation and provide access to the Downtown Glendale area for underserved community constituents, as well as neighboring communities and all City visitors alike. As part of this project, approximately 5,000 recycled tires will be used, reducing the amount of scrap rubber tires buried in landfills and impacting the environment. Finally, signal modifications will improve traffic flow and access along surface streets, reducing traffic delays and travel time and lowering fuel consumption and vehicle emissions.
