## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Strengthening Cyber-
- 5 security in Health Care Act".

## 1 SEC. 2. EVALUATION OF HHS CYBERSECURITY.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 2 years after the 3 date of enactment of this Act, and every 2 years thereafter, the Inspector General of the Department of Health 4 5 and Human Services shall evaluate the cybersecurity practices and protocols of the Department through the conduct 6 7 of penetration tests and other testing procedures to deter-8 mine how systems processing, transmitting, or storing 9 mission critical or sensitive data by, for, or on behalf of the Department is currently, or could be compromised 10 11 and—

12 (1) expose patient data, including Medicare13 numbers of individuals; or

14 (2) impact patient safety.

(b) REPORTS.—Not later than 2 years after the dateof enactment of this Act, and every 2 years thereafter—

(1) the Secretary of Health and Human Services shall submit to Congress a report that describes
how the Secretary will update the cybersecurity
practices and protocols of the Department of Health
and Human Services to adapt to the latest
cyberattack strategies; and

(2) the Inspector General of the Department of
Health and Human Services shall submit to Congress a report that describes—

1	(A) how the Inspector General is currently
2	using Federal funds of the Inspector General to
3	carry out subsection (a); and
4	(B) legislative changes required for the In-
5	spector General to maintain the evaluation de-
6	scribed in subsection (a).
